



The Armed Forces Banner Program was initiated by the City of Chino to honor and recognize Chino's military personnel.

To qualify, honorees must meet the following requirements:

- Active duty military personnel of the United States Armed Forces; or
- Inactive but served in the United States Armed Forces from October 7, 2001 - deactivation; and
- Current Chino resident; or
- Past resident with immediate family currently residing in Chino.  
(Immediate family = wife/husband, son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, son-in-law/daughter-in-law, aunt/uncle, and niece/nephew).

As an ongoing program, applications will be accepted at any time. Banners will be installed Bi-Annual: May and October. Timing of the banner installation and removal will be at the City's discretion. Banners may be displayed for a minimum of one (1) year, before being retired and given to honoree or honoree's family.

A follow-up email will notify the applicant of the week of installation for requested banner.
