



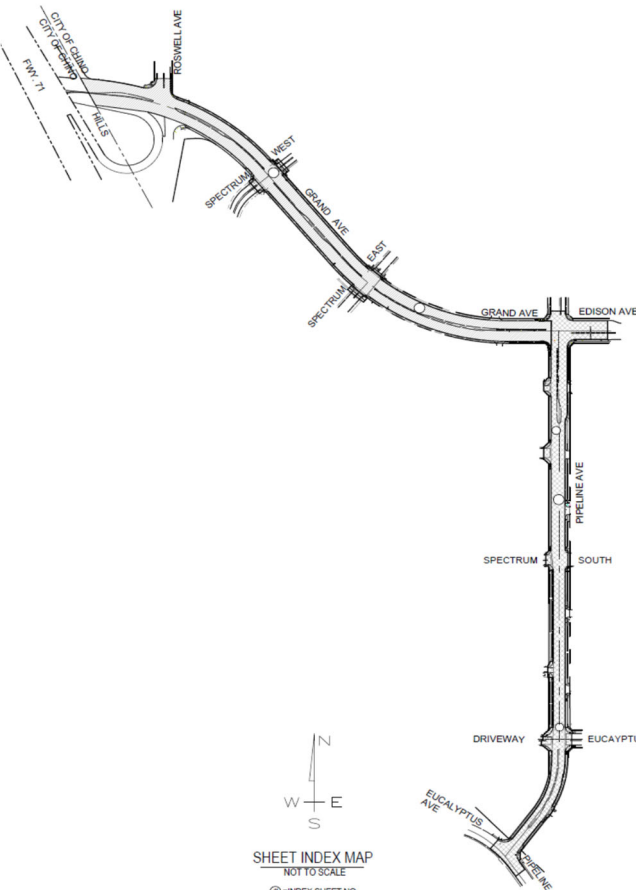

ALL BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS

The City of Chino is gearing up to commence construction along Pipeline Avenue and Grand Avenue. The project limits are on Grand Ave from the 71 Fwy to Pipeline and Pipeline Ave from Grand to Eucalyptus. The duration of this work is anticipated to start on March 6, 2023 and completed by March 31, 2023, weather permitting.

The construction will include asphalt rehabilitation, signage and striping work. Some driveway entrances and exits will be closed at times during construction and sometimes for extended periods. However, there will always be access to the shopping centers. Pedestrian access along sidewalks may be impacted, but a path of travel will be available at all times. Any necessary "No Parking" signs will be installed at least 48 hours in advance. Please obey no-parking signs. Working hours will be restricted from 7:00am to 4:00pm.

Please see the enclosed map showing the upcoming construction activities on the following weeks on this project. The schedule below will be updated as construction progress, and dates may be shifted due to weather conditions, material availability, plant shutdowns, or other unforeseen factors.



Phase 1, Asphalt Rehabilitation Grand Ave from the 71 Fwy to Pipeline and Pipeline Ave from Grand to Eucalyptus: Between March 6 and March 20, 2023, Contractor will grind and overlay the asphalt lanes on Grand Ave from the 71 Fwy to Pipeline and Pipeline Ave from Grand to Eucalyptus. Driveway access will be temporarily impacted for short periods of time to allow for grinding and paving operations. Alternative driveway access will be available at all times.

Phase 2, Signage and Striping: Between March 20, 2023 and March 31, 2023, Contractor will install new striping and signage at newly paved traffic areas. Traffic impacts to businesses will be relatively minimal. Any significant impacts caused due to striping will be coordinated at the time they become necessary.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation during the project. All measures will be taken to facilitate the work in a quick and timely fashion. We will take all measures to maintain access to your business as feasibly possible while work is under construction.
