TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES WITHIN THE CHINO YOUTH CHRISTMAS PARADE AND FAIR AREA

The City of Chino has granted permission for and is participating in the 2019 Chino Youth Christmas Parade and Fair, which will be held on **Saturday, December 14, 2019**. Streets in the area will begin to close at 6:00 a.m. and the Parade will step off at 9:00 a.m. We expect to have most roadways re-opened by 12:00 p.m. The Parade route is Riverside Drive (between Ramona Avenue and Central Avenue) and Central Avenue (between Riverside Drive and Chino Avenue).

Street closures will be kept to the shortest time possible with the Parade participants' safety in mind. During the time the streets are closed, no vehicles will be allowed on the Parade route except for those directly involved in the Parade. Personnel will make every effort to assist persons residing and doing business in the affected areas; however, non-participating vehicles will not be allowed in the area once the streets are closed.
